Qualifications and Experience

The successful candidate must possess a first degree with a major in Mathematics and/or Computer Sciences. A postgraduate degree in Computer Science would be an asset.

Candidates should preferably have experience in one or more of the following areas:

- Scripting using Perl or similar language
- Web development
- Microsoft Operating Systems, including Windows 98, 2000 and XP
- Unix or Linux Operating Systems
- Computer Networking
- Design of database programming in, for example, SQL, MySQL or Oracle

Special Responsibilities

- Assisting in setting up and developing seismic data-acquisition systems
- Integrating new and legacy seismic data processing software
- Developing and testing software products to meet agreed requirements in line with Centre processes and standards
- Undertaking support and maintenance of software products
- Developing and implementing automation of procedures for seismic, GPS, geothermal and other geophysical data
- Developing a data storage and retrieval system to archive seismic data and other data
- Interacting with software system users in the Centre to gather details on existing bugs and desirable upgrades
- Producing functional specifications and designs in response to requirements for changes to software products or for new and custom developments
- Other duties, as assigned

Personal Attributes

The Centre places high priority on individuals of integrity who can work well in a team and student friendly environment. Candidates should also possess good communication and interpersonal skills. A good command of both oral and written English is essential. Candidates must also be:

- Proficient in C/C++ and Java programming languages
- Familiar with seismic software packages, for instance Earthworm and Seisan
